Veiem alguns adverbis que es fan servir amb adjectius:

A BIT, FAIRLY, RATHER, VERY, REALLY, EXTREMELY.

Sempre hi van al davant dels adjectius als qui fan referència.

YOU'RE FAIRLY GOOD
THEY ARE RATHER BAD

A BIT és més col·loquial. Mai es fa servir amb l'adverbi WELL.

I AM A BIT BAD.
SHE IS A BIT ILL.

FAIRLY ho fem servir per adjectius positius i RATHER per als negatius.

YOUR GRANDFATHER IS FAIRLY GOOD
HIS GRANDMOTHER IS RATHER BAD
HER AUNT IS RATHER ILL.
